As part of its work, the Vacancy in See Committee wants to listen carefully to voices across the Diocese. As we discern who God may be calling as the next Bishop of Guildford, we warmly invite you to share your views through our diocesan consultation.

Highlight from last Sunday by *Richard Horn*

Richard's sermon centred on the **miracle of feeding the five thousand** and the profound nature of **divine compassion**.

Richard highlights how **Jesus chose to minister** to a needy crowd despite his own **personal grief** following the death of John the Baptist.

By analysing the dialogue between Christ and his disciples, the text explores the transition from **feeling empathy** to taking **sacrificial action**.

Richard emphasises that God utilises **human inadequacy and brokenness** to perform

miracles, urging the congregation to offer their limited resources to others. Ultimately, the source serves as a call for believers to act as the **physical presence of Christ** in a world requiring healing and sustenance.
